ORDINANCE NO. 20 -2018

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE CLARK COUNTY
FAMILY TREATMENT DRUG COURT
BRIDGE TO SUCCESS PROJECT GRANT FUND**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (the “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, the Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of Ind. Code § 36-1-2-9; and

WHEREAS, the Clark County Courts have been awarded grant funds from the United States Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration for Fiscal Year 2018; and

WHEREAS, as a requirement of the said grant program, a local, non-reverting, fund for the purpose of receipting, holding and expending allowable grant program local match funds, receipts and expenses must be established; and

WHEREAS, the Board now desires to establish the “Clark County Family Treatment Drug Court Bridge to Success Project Grant Fund” for the above stated purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE CLARK COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. Establishment:** The Clark County Family Treatment Drug Court Bridge to Success Project Grant Fund (the “Fund”), which is assigned **fund number 8100**, is hereby established as a local non-reverting fund to be administered and maintained by the Clark County Auditor.
- 2. Deposits into the Fund:** Only monies designated for the Clark County Family Treatment Drug Court Bridge to Success Project Grant Fund program and any local match funds shall be deposited into the Fund.
- 3. Purposes of Permitted Expenditures from the Fund:** Money in the Fund shall be used only to pay those expenses allowed pursuant to the Clark County Family Treatment Drug Court Bridge to Success Project Grant Fund program, which said purposes include the expansion of services to an additional 175 families through the Family Treatment Drug Court.


4. **Term of Fund:** The term of existence of the Fund shall be perpetual until the Fund is fully expended or terminated by subsequent ordinance adopted by this Board.
5. **Auditor's Duty to Manage the Fund:** The Clark County Auditor is hereby directed to maintain and manage accurate accounting information regarding the receipts, expenditures, and balances of the fund as well as any reporting requirements pursuant to Indiana law.
6. **Effective Date:** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.
