ORDINANCE NO. 4 -2013

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A FUND FOR THE
2011 CLARK COUNTY EMPLOYEE HEALTH INSURANCE REBATE**

WHEREAS, this Board of Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana (this “Board”), is the executive body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-2-2-2; and,

WHEREAS, this Board is also the legislative body of Clark County government pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-1-2-9; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Home Rule provisions of IC 36-1-3, *et seq.*, this Board has the authority to exercise all the powers needed for the effective operation of government as to local affairs, subject only to the limitations contained within statutes; and,

WHEREAS, this Board has identified the need to establish a fund into which the employee’s portion of the proceeds from the 2011 Clark County Health Insurance Rebate are to be deposited for reimbursement to the employees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by this Board of Clark County Commissioners as follows:

1. The establishment of the 2011 Clark County Employee Health Insurance Rebate Fund (hereinafter “Employee Health Insurance Rebate Fund”).
2. The Employee Health Insurance Rebate Fund shall be administered and maintained by the Clark County Auditor.

3. The Clark County Auditor shall have the authority to do what is necessary to disburse monies from the Employee Health Insurance Rebate Fund in order to satisfy the State Board of Accounts.

4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and promulgation as evidenced by the affirmative signatures of the undersigned as the majority of the duly elected and serving members of this Board.






