In the next order of business, Mr. Dixon told the Board that the Ohio River Bridge Maintenance Building project was a resubmittal and recommended approval. Mr. Coffman moved to approve the project. Mr. Killen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Hawthorn Glen Subdivision—Mr. Coffman moved to have Mr. Dixon contact Jeff Corbett about installing a small weir. Mr. Killen seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Yorktown Park Subdivision—Upon further review by Mr. Dixon, Mr. Kavanaugh moved that the

Board take no further action. Mr. Coffman seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

In the next order of business, Mr. Dixon discussed issuing a new contract with Jay Thompson to once again inspect county outfalls as part of the MS4 program.
