

REGULAR MEETING
CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
January 30, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana met in Regular Session on January 30, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. in Room 103, Clark County Government Building, in Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Present at the meeting were Commissioners – Bryan Glover, Jack Coffman and Connie Sellers, Attorney Scott Lewis, Commissioners’ Assistant Sabrina Corbin and Auditor Danny Yost.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Commissioner Glover. Prayer was led by Jack Coffman.

Approval of the Minutes

Commissioner Coffman motioned to approve the January 16, 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Danny Yost presented the claims and payroll for January 30, 2025. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the claims and payroll. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Commissioner Glover asked for any amendments to the agenda if not he would entertain a motion to approve. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the agenda as presented. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Ed Wilkinson who lives at 6205 Charlestown Pike came to speak to the Clark County Commissions about the road widening project. He is questioning why the water line is being zigzagged. Commissioner Glover stated they would reach out to the engineers to get an answer.

- A. Commissioner Sellers motioned to table the Opioid Settlement Restricted Funds Request from Homeless Coalition of Southern Indiana as no one showed up to speak regarding this and there are several questions regarding their request. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- B. Attorney Scott Lewis, presented Baker Tilly Master Service Agreement for Accounting and Reporting Support for the Auditor's Office. This is with an amount to not exceed 25,000. Commissioner Coffman motioned to approve Baker Tilly Master Service Agreement for Accounting and Reporting Support for the Auditor's Office for 2025. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- C. Commissioners' Assistant Sabrina Corbin presented LOW- Claim Entry with Attachment Annual Maintenance for the Auditor's Office. This is a service that will allow the Auditor's Office to upload Ordinances, contracts, and subrecipient agreements to claims as well as funds directly into LOW. The cost of this would be \$4,000 annually and would come from the Auditor's Fund. Commissioner Coffman motioned to approve LOW- Claim Entry with Attachment Annual Maintenance for the Auditor's Office. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

D. Sheriff: Major Nick Mobley stated that the current jail population is 469 and 30 are Federal Inmates.


