

REGULAR MEETING
CLARK COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
March 27, 2025

The Board of County Commissioners of Clark County, Indiana met in Regular Session on March 27, 2025, at 5:00 p.m. in Room 103, Clark County Government Building, in Jeffersonville, Indiana.

Present at the meeting were Commissioners – Bryan Glover, Jack Coffman and Connie Sellers, Attorney Scott Lewis, Commissioners' Assistant Sabrina Corbin and Auditor Danny Yost.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Judge Lisa Reger. Prayer was led by Commissioner Jack Coffman.

Approval of the Minutes

Commissioner Coffman motioned to approve the March 12, 2025 Regular Meeting Minutes. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Danny Yost presented the claims and payroll for March 27, 2025. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the claims and payroll. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

Commissioner Glover asked for any amendments to the agenda if not he would entertain a motion to approve. Commissioner Sellers motioned to approve the agenda as presented. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

I. Public Comments:

Jason Cochran, Chief of New Washington Volunteer Fire Department came to speak to the Commissioners to share information about the Lucas Device (Automated CPR Device). Chief Cochran wanted to share his gratitude to the Health Department for getting the funding to get the device and that the Lucas Device does save lives.

II. New Business:

- A.** Scott Lewis, County Attorney, presented the Emergency Road Repair - Lance Court Proposals. The County has a partial road collapse at Lance Court. Under Indiana Law, upon the declaration of an emergency, it allows for two quotes to be requested instead of the public bidding process which can take months. Since this is an emergency situation and to prevent a further collapse of the road the County has declared an emergency. The County has requested two quotes, one being from Geo-Stabilization International (GSI). Their quotes is the amount of \$414,200. The second quote requested is from Beaty Construction Inc. Their quote is in the amount of \$600,000. The County Engineer looked at both quotes and gave a recommendation to go with GSI, the lower quote. Commissioner Coffman made a motion to declare an emergency on the Lance Court roadway and accept the quote from GSI in the amount of \$414,200. Commissioner Sellers seconded. Motion Approved 3-0
- B.** Scott Lewis, County Attorney, presented the Accretive Global Insurance Service Agreement for Dependent Eligibility Verification Services for HR. This is considered best practices in the insurance industry to conduct periodic audit to ensure eligibility of dependents on our insurance plan. This contract was for \$8,800. Commissioner Sellers motion to approve Accretive Global Insurance Service Agreement for Dependent Eligibility Verification Services for HR for \$8,800. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion Approved 3-0
- C.** Judge Lisa Reger, presented Clark County Problem Solving Court Opioid Funds Request. Judge Reger explained the impact that these courts have on the individuals, first responders, and the community. They are requesting \$86,000 for transportation, supplies, drug testing, and contract services. Commissioner Seller motioned to approve Clark County Problem Solving Court Opioid Funds Request for \$86,000 from the Restricted Fund. Commissioner Coffman seconded. Motion approved 3-0.
- D.** Scott Lewis, County Attorney, presented the 2025 Community Corrections Supervisor Grant Application Letter of Support. This is an annual grant request that the Clark County Community Correction Advisory Board makes to the State of Indiana. The State of Indiana requires a Letter of Support from the Commissioners as part of the application process. Commissioner Coffman motions to approve the 2025 Community Corrections Supervisor Grant Application Letter of Support. Commissioner Seller seconded. Motion approved 3-0.

C. Highway Department: Brian Dixon, County Engineer, thanked the Commissioners for approving the Proposal for the Emergency Road Repair of Lance Court. Mr. Dixon stated that both proposals didn't cover all the cost and that he is working on contacting the Engineering Contractor who did the initial work to get a proposal from them to get help to see where they need to take it. He also stated he needed to look into paving and utility coordination.




