Councilperson Lenfert motioned to approve the appointments as listed. Councilperson Doherty seconded. Motion approved 7-0.

Fire Chief Mousavi with Tri-Township Fire District presented a request of additional appropriations due to a clerical error. The requested amount totals out to \$2,641,244.64. Motion from Councilperson Miller to approve the Tri-Township Fire District Ordinance #1-2023 Additional Appropriations. Seconded by Councilperson Doherty. Motion approved 7-0.

Commissioner President Bryan Glover presented a request for a transfer of appropriations of \$50,0000 for fund 1169. Henryville-Memphis sanitation corporation are requesting funding in the amount of \$2,500,000. Rural Memphis sanitation corporation requested \$2,950,000. The council disclosed the amount of \$1,500,000 million dollars to extend water services out towards Highway 31. All services to be approved for \$7,100,000 into fund 8950. Motion by Councilperson Lenfert. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 7-0.

Councilperson Lenfert wanted to thank Sarah of the Highway department after her audit of the mileage of roads that are throughout Clark County. Sarah found miles of road that have not been reported to the State which will help the county get the correct amount of funding from the state.

Tom Lowe with the Clark County Courts presented a request for \$25,000 which is an additional appropriation for a Capital Case. County General has requested \$18,901.00 which is an adult guardianship local match. Veterans court IDOC 1 additional appropriation is an annual grant that will be awarded to Clark County but transferred to Floyd County. Motion from Councilperson Lenfert to approve the additional appropriation of \$25,000 for court fund litigation expenses, the \$18,901 for local match and to table all the requests for additional appropriation for fund 9153. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 7-0.

James Hayden with the Clark County Probation department presented a request of \$57,000 for Public Defenders. Motion was made from Councilperson Doherty to approve the appropriation request in the amount of \$57,000 for Clark County Probation Pre-Trial IDOC #1 in fund 9161. Seconded by Councilperson Lenfert. Motion approved 7-0.

Doug Bentfield with the Clark County Health Department presented a request of additional appropriations for three different grants. The appropriations will go to the Clark

County Health Department for LHD Comm Testing Site, Ryan White Services and HIV Prevention in funds 8233, 8234 and 9151. All appropriations amount to \$367,705.64. Motion by Councilperson Doherty to approve. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 7-0.

Clark County Treasurer Monty Snelling presented a request for additional appropriations to the County General fund, Rainy Day Fund, and the Riverboat Fund. There was also a discussion on the Salary Ordinance for County General. The salary ordinance statement did not match the 144 that was turned in. The same amount of money is getting spent, the persons are just moving positions and the money would need to be transferred. Councilperson Doherty motioned to table. Seconded by Councilperson Miller. Motion approved 7-0.

Councilperson Vissing motioned to adjourn. Councilperson Miller seconded. Motion approved 7-0.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CLARK COUNTY COUNCIL CONCERNING ADDITIONAL APPROPRIATIONS FOR THOSE FUNDS WHICH DO NOT REQUIRE APPROVAL OF THE DEPARTMENT OF LOCAL GOVERNMENT FINANCE ORDINANCE NO. 2-2023

WHEREAS, certain extraordinary conditions have developed since the adoption of the existing annual budget so that it is necessary to appropriate more money than was appropriated in the annual budget.

Section I. BE IT ORDAINED by the Clark County Council of Clark County, Indiana that for expenses of Clark County government and its institutions for the year ending December 31, 2023, the following sums of money are herein specified subject to the law governing the same, such sum herein appropriated shall be held to include all expenditures provided by law.

Section II. THAT for the fiscal year there is hereby appropriated out of the various funds herein for the following specified amounts to meet such extraordinary emergencies which are declared to exist.
