The Clark County Drainage Board met on June 19, 2014, in Room 418, Clark County Government Building, Jeffersonville, Indiana, at 4:00pm. Present at the meeting were President John Perkins, member Mike Killen, Ex-Officio non-voting member County Surveyor David Blankenbeker, non-voting advisor County Engineer Brian Dixon and Attorney Bob Bottorff. Les Kavanaugh was absent.

In the first order of business, Mr. Killen moved to table review of the minutes of the May 15, 2014 meeting in Mr. Kavanaugh's absence. Mr. Perkins seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

In the next order of business, the Board heard drainage complaints from the public. Paul Farmer, 310 Erin Lane, Ridgeview Acres, Henryville—Could not attend and Charles E. Keener, 308 Erin Lane—Carolyn Keener addressed the Board. Mr. Dixon will meet with Steve Brewer, Mr. Farmer & Ms. Keener and report back to the Board at the July meeting.

Michelle R. Miller, 207 Prall Road, Henryville—She was not present, but after Mr. Dixon gave his report, Mr. Killen moved to have the County Highway Department improve the ditch along Prall Road for about 100' to alleviate standing water. Mr. Perkins seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

Ronald A. Zimmerman, 11922 Magellan Way, Fields of Perry Crossing, Sellersburg,—was instructed to form a Home Owners Association. No action was taken by the Board.

Richard Stock, 5519 Covington Drive, Hawthorn Glen Sec. 5, Charlestown and Rodney R. Lewis, 5521 Covington Drive, Hawthorn Glen Sec. 5, Charlestown—Mr. Stock stated that debris enters property from adjacent property. Mr. Dixon will instruct Lynn Miller of CCSWD to continue to inspect. Mr. Dixon will also talk with the developer, Jeff Corbett.
